

October Share The Basket: Poco a Poco


Each month, LCUUF donates 5000 pesos or more to an organization in our Lakeside community. We share one half of the offering collected at the Fellowship each week with that organization. For the month of April we will be supporting Poco a Poco which helps people in the San Pedro Itzican area. This organization supports youth and women in this indigenous

area, through education, teaching local organic food growth, providing food and drinking water to renal patients, feeding over 300 children 5 days a week, offering health services, as well as literacy and English as a second language classes. They now have six community kitchens in the area!

Introduction To The Enneagram

The Enneagram is a personality system that categorizes individuals into nine distinct personality types,



each with its own set of characteristics, motivations, and growth paths. It offers insights into how people perceive and respond to the world around them.

- **Session 1** will introduce the Nine Types and their behaviors and motivations.
- **Session 2** will discuss points of connection and growth as well as any questions or observations that came up for participants between the sessions.
